





Gospel Luke 21:25-36


The Gospel according to Luke, the twenty-first chapter. Glory to you, O Lord.

The peace of Jesus is with you always. And also with you.



Lord's Prayer


Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us:






