Worship leaders will indicate when to stand and sit, as you are able.





Let us confess our sins to God and to one another.


(Time for silent reflection)



The Gospel according to Luke, the eighth chapter. Glory to you, O Lord.






For as often as we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the mystery of faith, that **Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.**



### **Post Communion Prayer**




