### PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

Advent greetings to each of you and to all those you love.

fter a couple months of attending some Cottage Meetings and talking with several of you, I wanted to let you know some of what I learned.

Allow me to start with an invitation. There are a few of you who voiced interest in taking the trip in what I call "our catacombs." These are tunnels that go under the church and are a part of the solution to the time when the church was sinking in the 1960-70s. As your youth and family minister, I took the kids down there often, and we would do a short worship service underneath the pulpit. If you would like to join this group in exploring (it is not as intense as spelunking) please let me know and we will find a time for all of us. You will need to wear a hard hat or bike helmet.

At our Cottage Meetings, some folks indicated they liked the more positive energy that seems to be enveloping the congregation, especially after the April retreat with Pr Brenna Ziemet. There was some thanksgiving for new members and renewed Sunday school, as well as the fun of the Fall Festival. We had one discussion about if we are doing too much as a small congregation, yet we also talked about how great it is that we are getting better connected to our neighbors.

Some asked about the parking lot changes with chains and buckets. This is to respond to our neighbors' frustrations about people being noisy and doing donuts in our lot at all hours of the

night. Some asked about our sanctuary roof and solar panels. We are getting more money from our insurance company to move forward with plans for the sanctuary roof. The solar panels are working just fine, and I hope those of you who subscribed are getting your discounts. Others indicated we need some new transistor hearing devices for worship, and we are looking into this.

Finally, there was a question about my plans as your pastor, because some of you know that my wife has recently retired. My response was, "I have no plans to depart Bethel before my own retirement age, if you will continue to have me." Mary is six years older than me, so I have some work time left. I am also open for change if Bethel needs to change things, so know that you are also not stuck with me! I am very grateful to the Personnel and Board of Administrators members for granting me more vacation time, as I have been your pastor for 12+ years and have never had an increase in this. So, although I might be gone a bit more next year traveling with my retired wife, I intend to continue to serve this wonderful faith community.

If anyone wants to speak with me further or invite me to another Cottage Meeting at your home with a group of people, I am more than willing to meet with any or all of you. Know that my door is always open, and I would love to hear what you are thinking about Bethel - past, present, and future. Friends, we are doing just

fine, and God blesses us more than we even know!

# MICHELLE'S GRANTS UPDATE

#### Dear Bethel,

Thank you for participating in the Grants life of Bethel! This year, you participated in Thrivent Action Teams, bringing in more than \$2,000 to Bethel to help us feed volunteers, celebrate our Fall Festival well, and to help purchase supplies to clean up our property this spring!

You also participated in Give to the Max Day '24, helping Bethel raise funds for new ministry outreach to establish Queer Safe Sober Space at Bethel. Thanks to your participation and matching funds from the Lenore Bevis Memorial, we raised \$3975.00 for a new ministry! It is exciting to pursue new opportunities to meet the people God will bring to us and to see where those relationships will lead Bethel.

In October, Bethel was awarded a \$750 grant from the Fairview Interfaith Health Collaborative. These funds will be used to offer an evening "Paint the Town" canvas painting and hors d'oeuvres event in the summer of 2025. Thanks to the support of funders like Fairview, Bethel is bringing people together to learn, laugh, and lean on each other.

I am happy to report too that we have been spending our other grant funds! We are hosting events and thinking creatively how to leverage our community's gifts and skills to equip Bethel to pursue new ministry opportunities!

# FEASIBILITY UPDATE

ast month we were focused on three areas of our work. Here is a brief update on each of those.

- We are still waiting to continue our discussion with El Colegio as they begin working on adding grades K-8 to their school.
- Our lawyers will soon be taking a look at our contracts with Crown Castle, the owners of the monopole.
- We have found a professional organization that may potentially be who we hire to conduct a neighborhood survey. We are working on what questions we would like to ask our neighbors. We will meet with a representative from this company at our December meeting.

We are also looking at revisions for our mission statement to help us match it up with what the neighborhood needs and what future potential partners may be interested in as a mission in this neighborhood. Please keep in mind that this process of finding partnerships for our building is going to take some time.

We had some homework for this meeting, reviewing and thinking about our mission statement and other statements that we use. We had a nice start to a discussion about this and notes from that will be shared with the Feasibility Study Group. We also talked about possible new renters and the need to review some of our lesser-used spaces to determine if they could be available for longer-term

rental. We have really increased our income from rentals this year and it sounds like the goal for next year will be even higher.

Some things coming up in the near and longer term are creating next year's budget and conducting an internal audit. Then we will set a date for our next Congregational Meeting to be held in February or March.
